The funeral took place at the First Congregational Church, Oakland, Cal., Sunday afternoon, March 24th, 1873. The rear dais and the organ loft were beautifully decked with wreaths and festoons of green leaves, immortelles, camelias and white roses. Wreaths were laid on the cover of the casket, and at the head was a large cross, composed of camelias and evergreens. The pall-bearers were S. W. Sanderson, John Cur-rey, A. L. Rhodes, Samuel Merritt, John W. Dwindle, William T. Wallace, Joseph P. Hoge, J. D. Thornton, Edmond L. Goold, J. B. Crockett and Henry Durant. The services were conducted by Rev. L. Hamilton, of the Independent Presbyterian Church; Rev. H. J. McLean, of the First Congregational, assisting. The following remarks were made by the Rev. Dr. Siebbins: Events in the life of the individual man tend to conclusion while society moves on...
