National estimates for sheriffs offices are provided for such issues as staff and financial resources, technologies and equipment in use, and agency policies and practices covering a wide array of law enforcement and administrative concerns. Highlights include the following: In 2003 starting salaries for entry-level deputies ranged from an average of about \$23,300 in the smallest jurisdictions to about \$38,800 in the largest. From 1990 to 2003 the percentage of sheriffs offices using infield computers increased from 6 to 55 . Ten percent of sheriffs offices employing 31 of all officers, maintained or created a written community policing plan during the 12-moth period ending June 30, 2003.
