He entered the service of the Standard Bank of South Africa, Limited, in 1881, and was posted to the Port Elizabeth Branch. A year later he was transferred to the General Managers Department at Cape Town, and, in 1889, he became Secretary to the General Managers. Cape Town is the headquarters of the Bank in South Africa, and his services at headquarters were so highly valued that he was retained there in various offices until he retired in 1914, after completing a service of thirty-three years.
