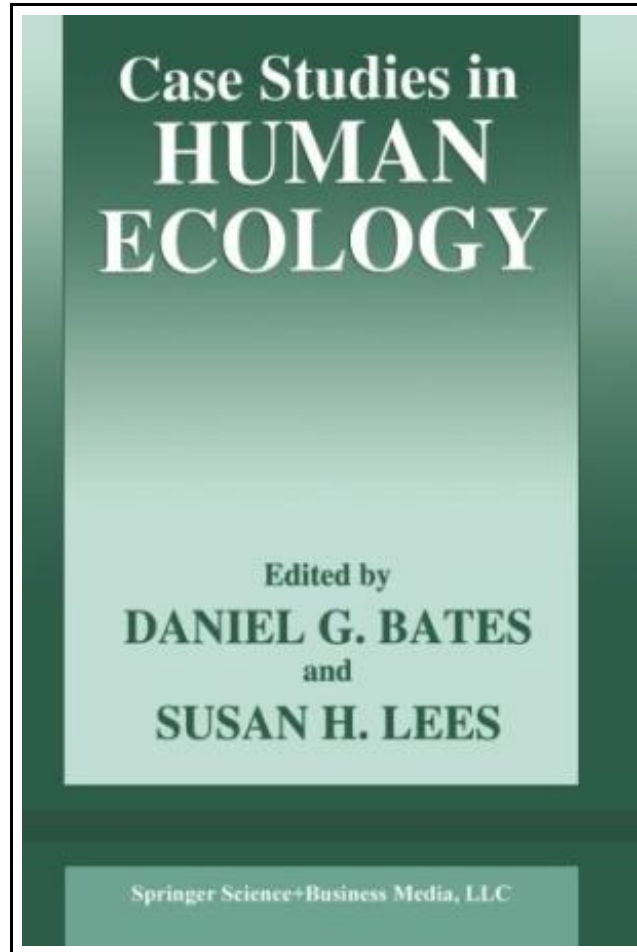

These are usually discussed either along the lines of distinctive strategies of food procurement (such as foraging or pastoralism) or as adaptations to specific habitat types or biomes (such as the circumpolar regions or arid lands).
